In Sybiz Vision many users with larger inventories manually create count sheets, then consolidate them onto a spreadsheet, then re-key them into Vision – very time consuming.

This system allowed the users to create stocktake count sheets that ensured that there was no superfluous inventory items as well as allowing for ad-hoc stocktake count sheets to be created. It then used the information in these named or numbered stocksheets to allow the entry of the actual stocktake count. So all the user had to do was pick up the sheet, find it in the system and then type the number counted against that stocksheets.

The program also allowed for altering the cost of the inventory items prior to or after the stocktake. In this case quick entry of stock figures was paramount, and so a system was devised that allowed the stock figure to be entered and the up and down arrow or enter key be used to move to the next field.

The information would then be processed into Sybiz Vision using the autoloading feature that Sybiz provide.
