SBS 2003 enables your staff to communicate better with each other on many levels:

Exchange Server 2003 is a powerful email system that allows for internal calendar sharing, improved Web email access and integrated support for synchronising with mobile devices (such as O2 and i-mate) whilst maintaining its traditional external email systems.

If you also have registered a DNS hostname (eg. mysmallbusiness.com.au), you can have a professional looking external email address to give to your business contacts. You can have more than one address, as well; for example jbloggs@mysmallbusiness.com.au can be set up to receive mail sent to admin@mysmallbusiness.com.au and / or accounts@mysmallbusiness.com.au. You can also set up distribution lists, such as sales@mysmallbusiness.com.au or info@mysmallbusiness.com.au, which can be internally delivered to singular or multiple users.

SharePoint Services is a company intranet solution which provides users with a central point at which to share information. This powerful feature of SBS 2003 is configured out of the box to display announcements and upcoming events on the main page, and links to lists (for example, a Help Desk list), surveys and fully customisable document repositories – similar to an electronic bulletin board.

Remote Web Workplace is geared towards staff that conduct many of their duties away from the office. It provides Internet access to your SharePoint site (with the correct credentials, thus protecting it from other Internet users) and allows you to send, receive and manage your email via Outlook Web Access. You can also perform administration on most workstations from here, and directly access the server desktop (this would decrease support costs with less need for site visits).
