GST and BAS - Part Two

In the last article we looked at common transaction posting problems in Sybiz Vision. The important thing to remember is that Sybiz Vision will calculate GST at the GST Rate you apply to the transaction even if you can alter the GST Amount on processing the transaction.

In this article we look at what happens once the transaction is posted and we need to gather that information to then construct a BAS Report.
